SUBJECT: Food and Alcohol Restrictions

As part of the Commonwealth's response to the COVID-19 global pandemic, to lessen the impact of the COVID-19 emergency, and to protect and safeguard the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, it has been necessary to adjust certain KBWC-related rules in response to public health metrics and the advice of public health practitioners. This memo updates information regarding the temporary restrictions for combat sports in the Commonwealth that were imposed in January.

As of May 1, 2021:

- Capacity will be set by the Kentucky Healthy At Work venue guidelines, as posted at the following website: govstatus.egov.com/ky-healthy-at-work;
- All Healthy at Work mandates must be strictly followed; and
- Food and beverage sales, including alcohol sales, may resume.

To be clear, all requirements for the Kentucky Healthy at Work must be strictly enforced, and consequences may ensue if guidelines are not strictly followed. A critical component of the Healthy at Work guidelines is that facial coverings must be worn at all times unless actively eating and/or drinking. If noncompliance with mask mandates, or other COVID-19 mandates, is observed due to permitting the resumption of food and beverage sales, the ban on sales may have to be reinstated. Accordingly, we strongly encourage all promoters to task all employees and volunteers with ensuring that all protocols and guidelines are followed by fellow employees, volunteers, combatants, guests, and fans. We thank you in advance for your vigilance in ensuring all mandates are followed.
